About the Award:

Established in 2003, the Outstanding Young Alumnus/Alumna Award recognizes a graduate of the Department of Civil, Architectural and Environmental Engineering under the age of 40 who has distinguished him or herself with outstanding service and contributions to the engineering profession and community.

Eligibility:

The nominee must have received a degree (BS, MS or Ph.D.) from the Department of Civil, Architectural and Environmental Engineering at the University of Texas at Austin and 40 years of age or younger by July 1 of the nominating year.

Award Criteria (Nominee's career accomplishments):

- Distinguished professional achievements.
- Contributions to engineering profession and community and/or service to the Department of Civil, Architectural and Environmental Engineering, Cockrell School of Engineering, and/or University of Texas at Austin
- Community activities (involvement in public service, service organizations, and/or charitable causes).
